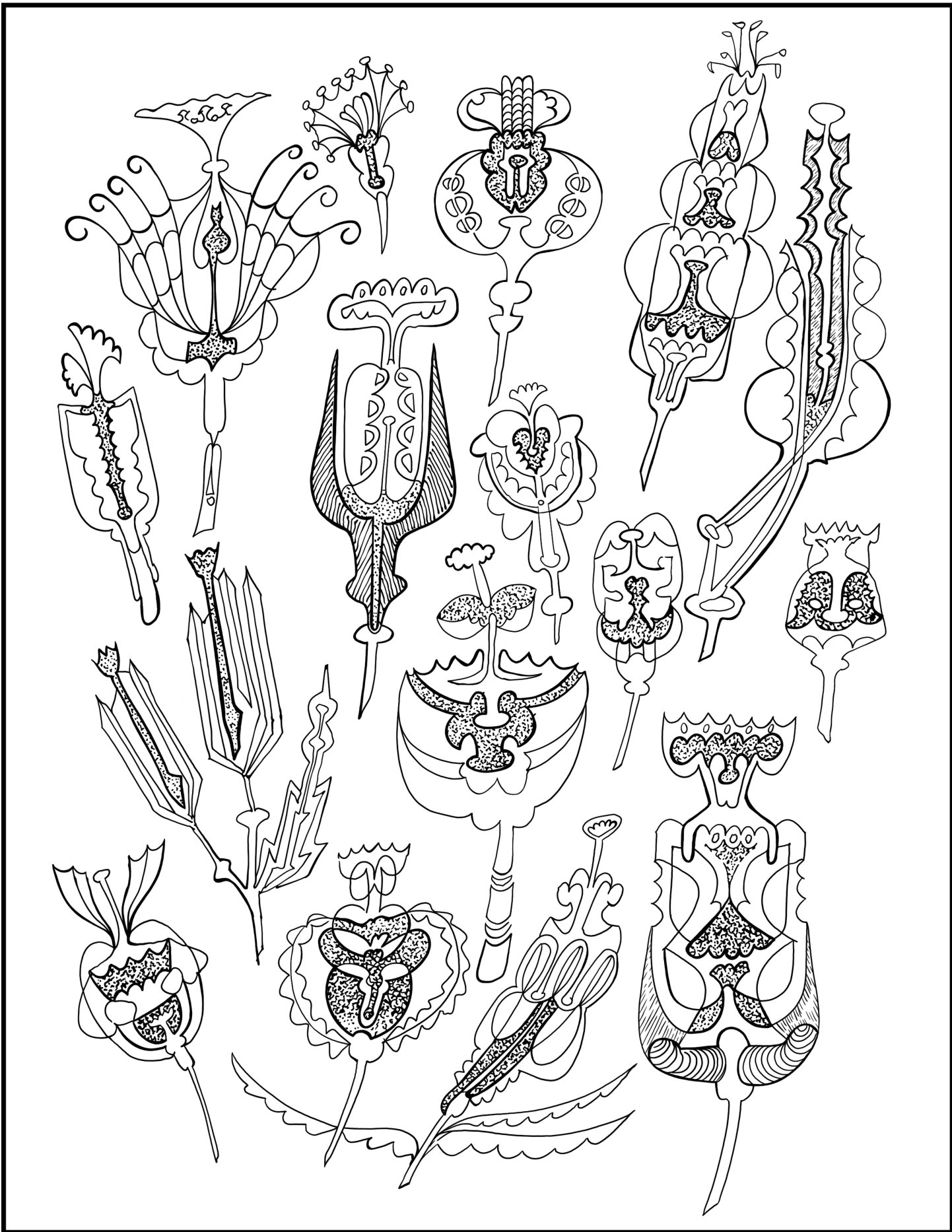

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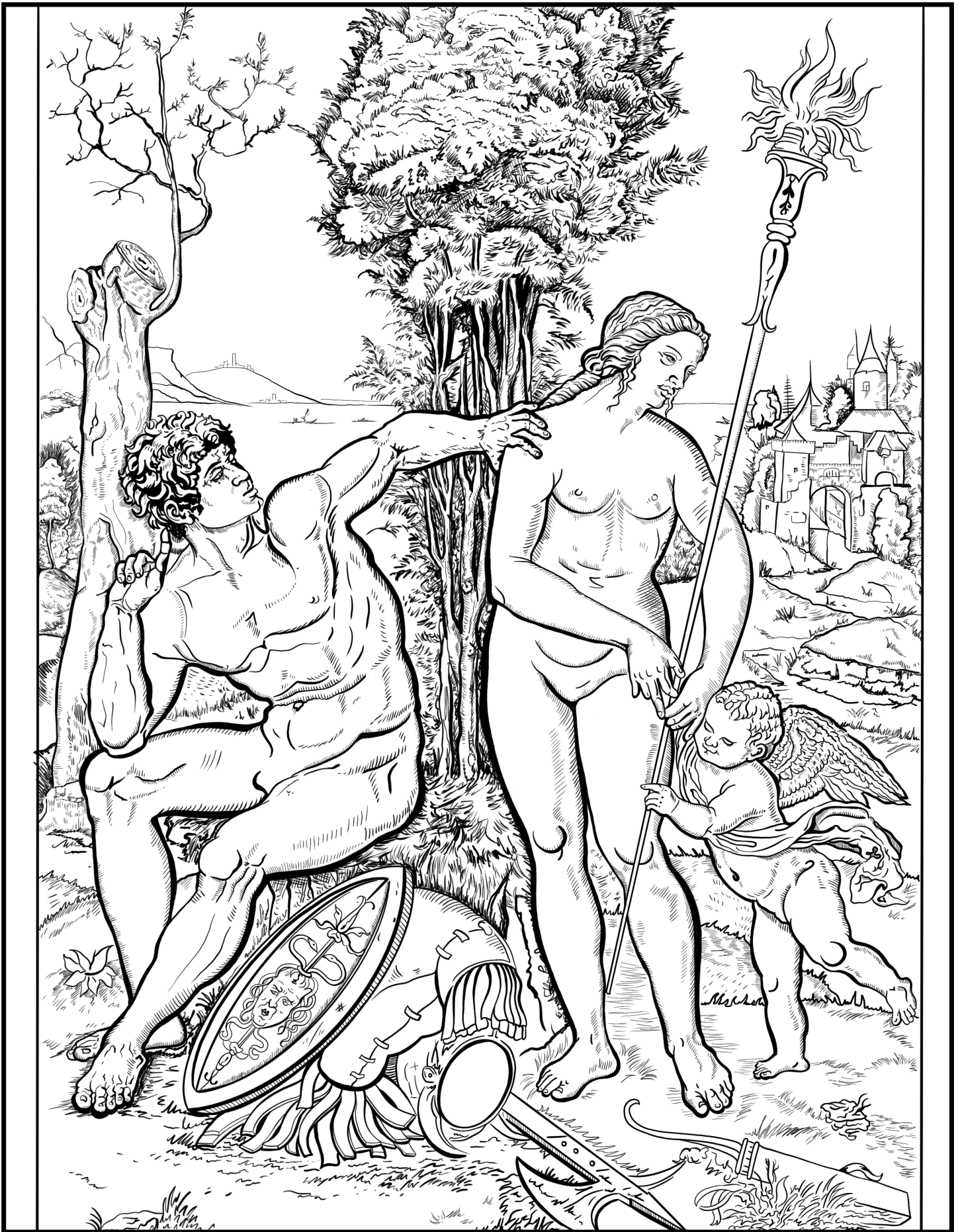
1. Utagawa Hiroshige (Japanese, 1797–1858), **Suido Bridge and Surugadai**, 1857



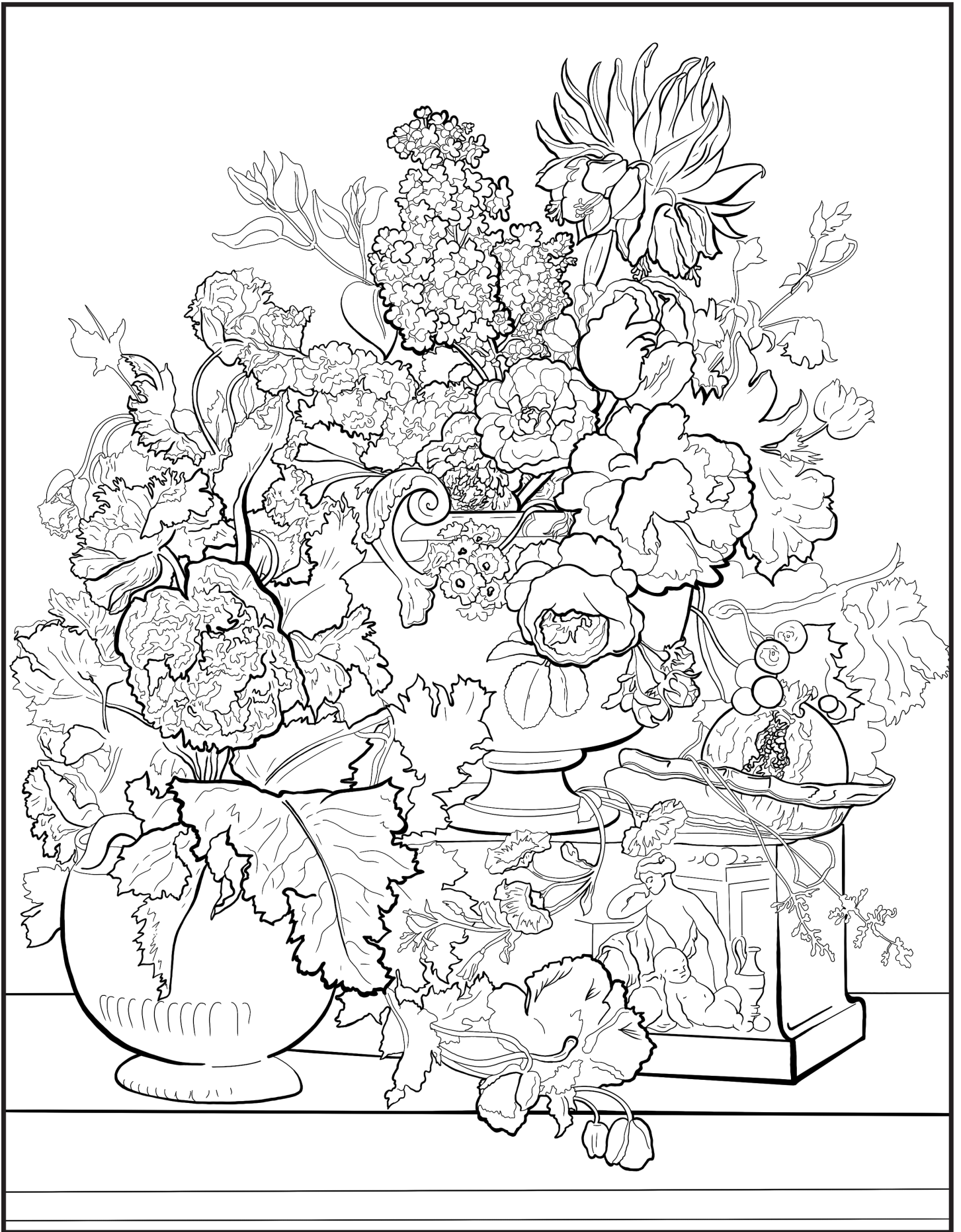
2. Anwar Jalal Shemza (Pakistani, 1928–1985), **Poppy Heads**, 1977



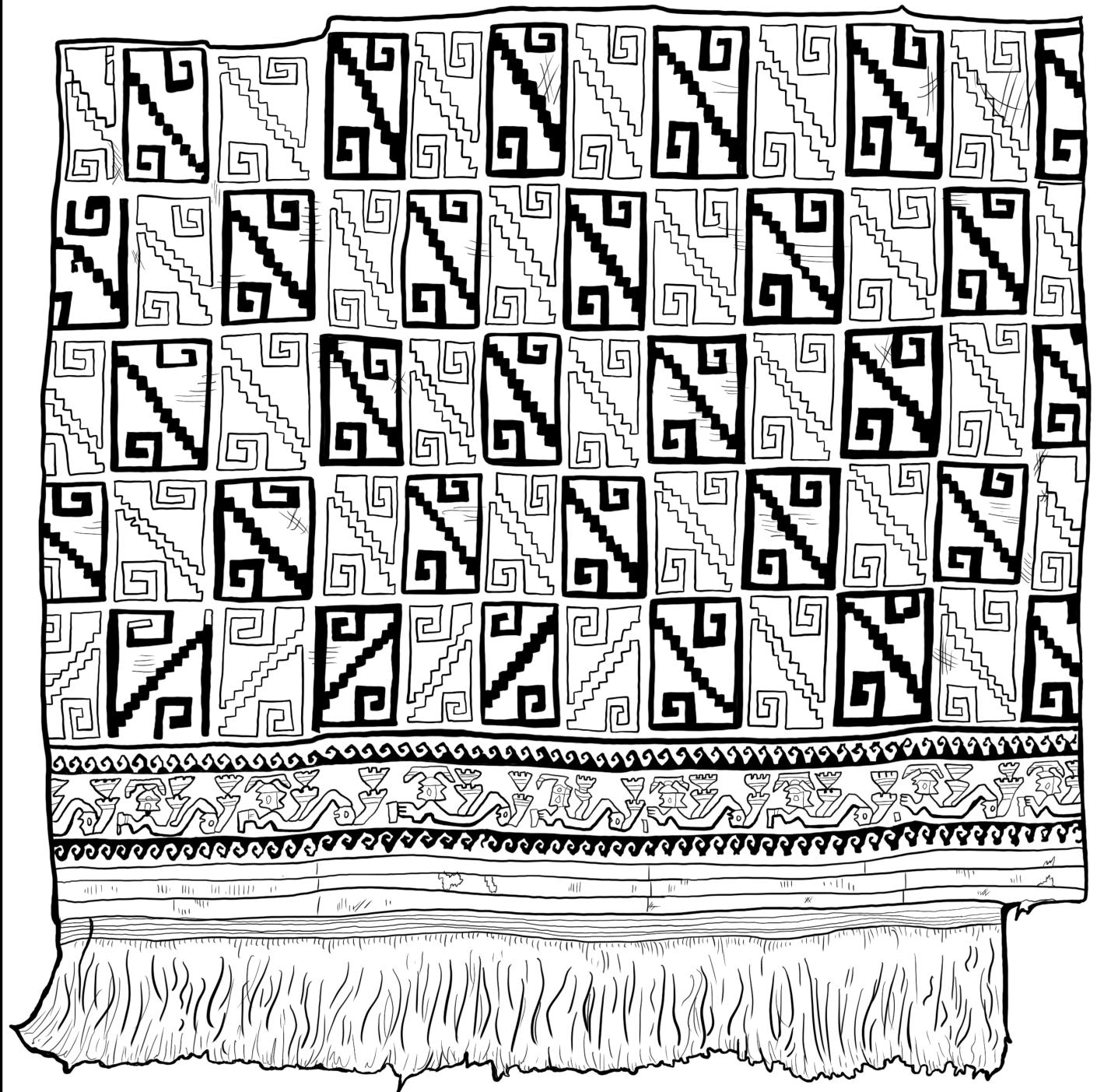
3. India, Rajasthan, Bundi. **Malasri Ragini: A Woman Plucks the Petals of a Lotus Flower**, 18th century



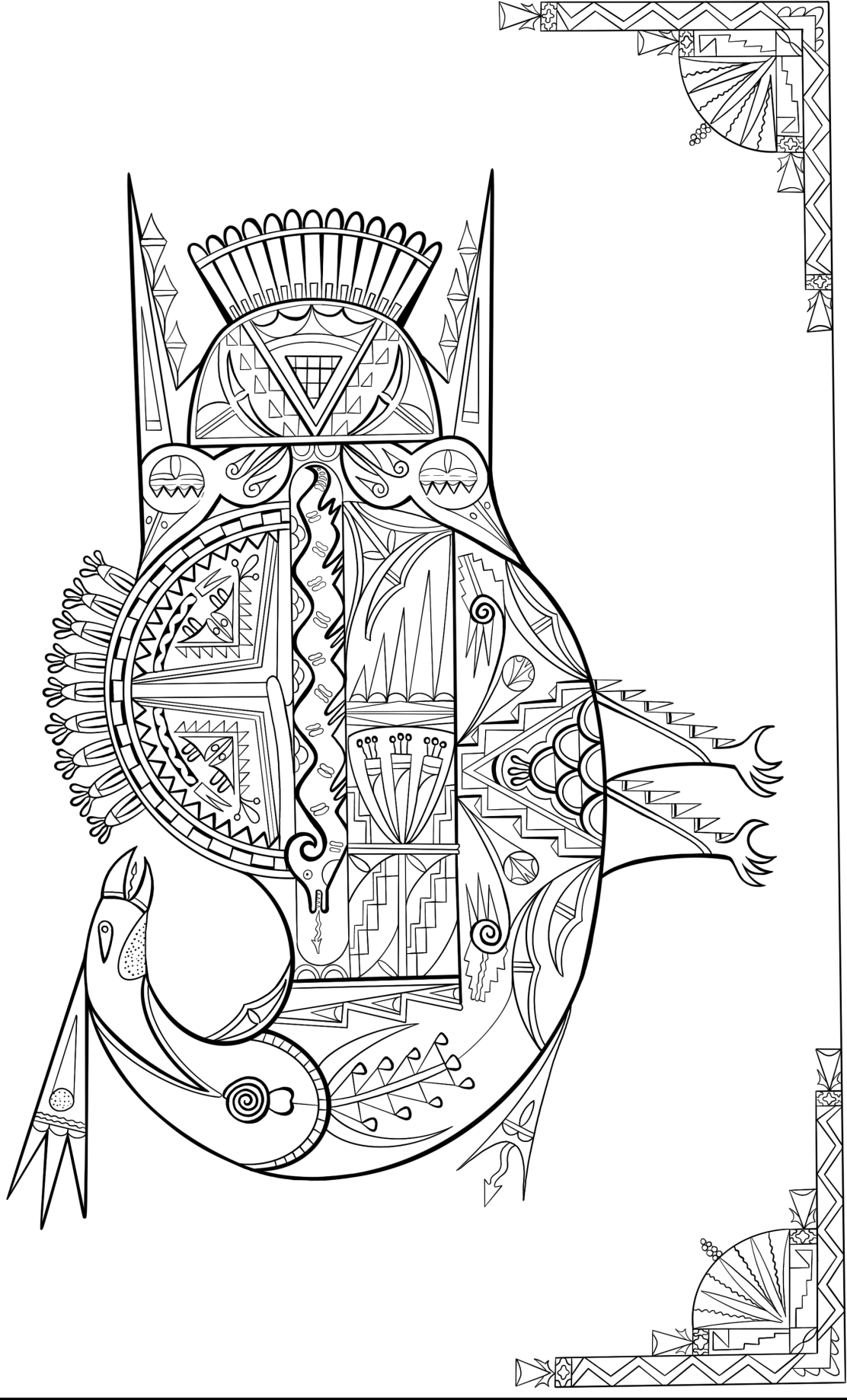
4. Marcantonio Raimondi (Italian, 1480–1534), *Mars, Venus, and Cupid*, 1508



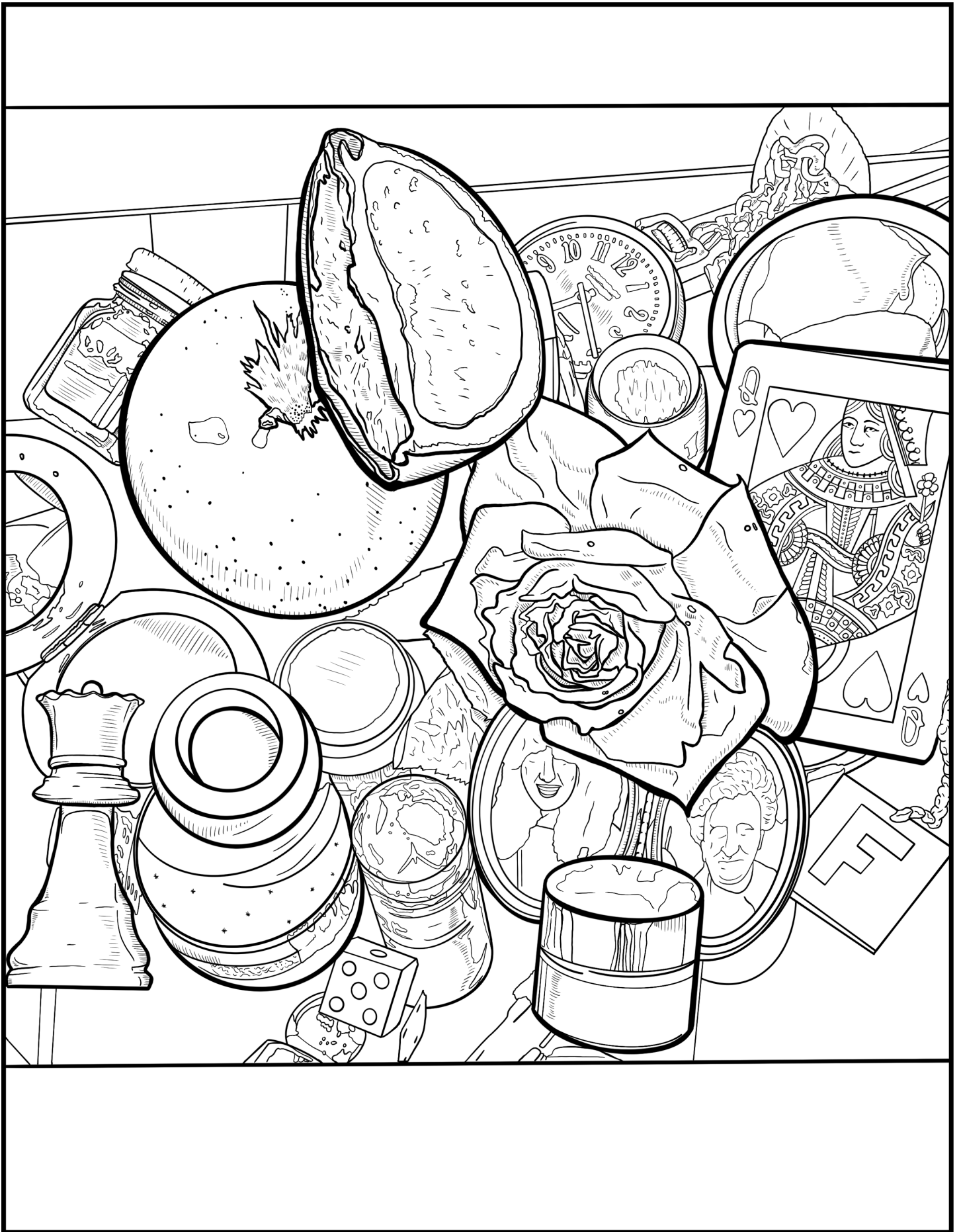

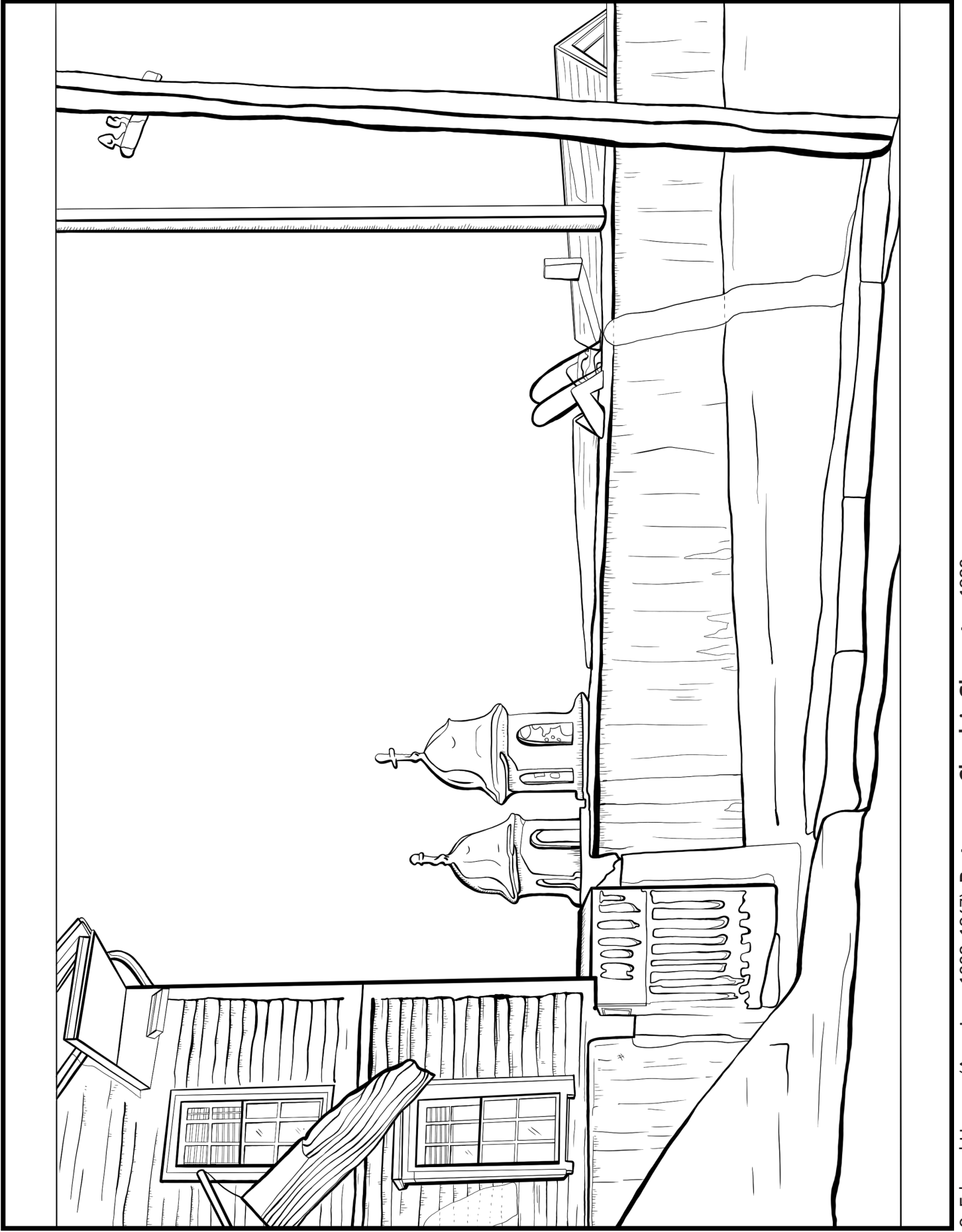

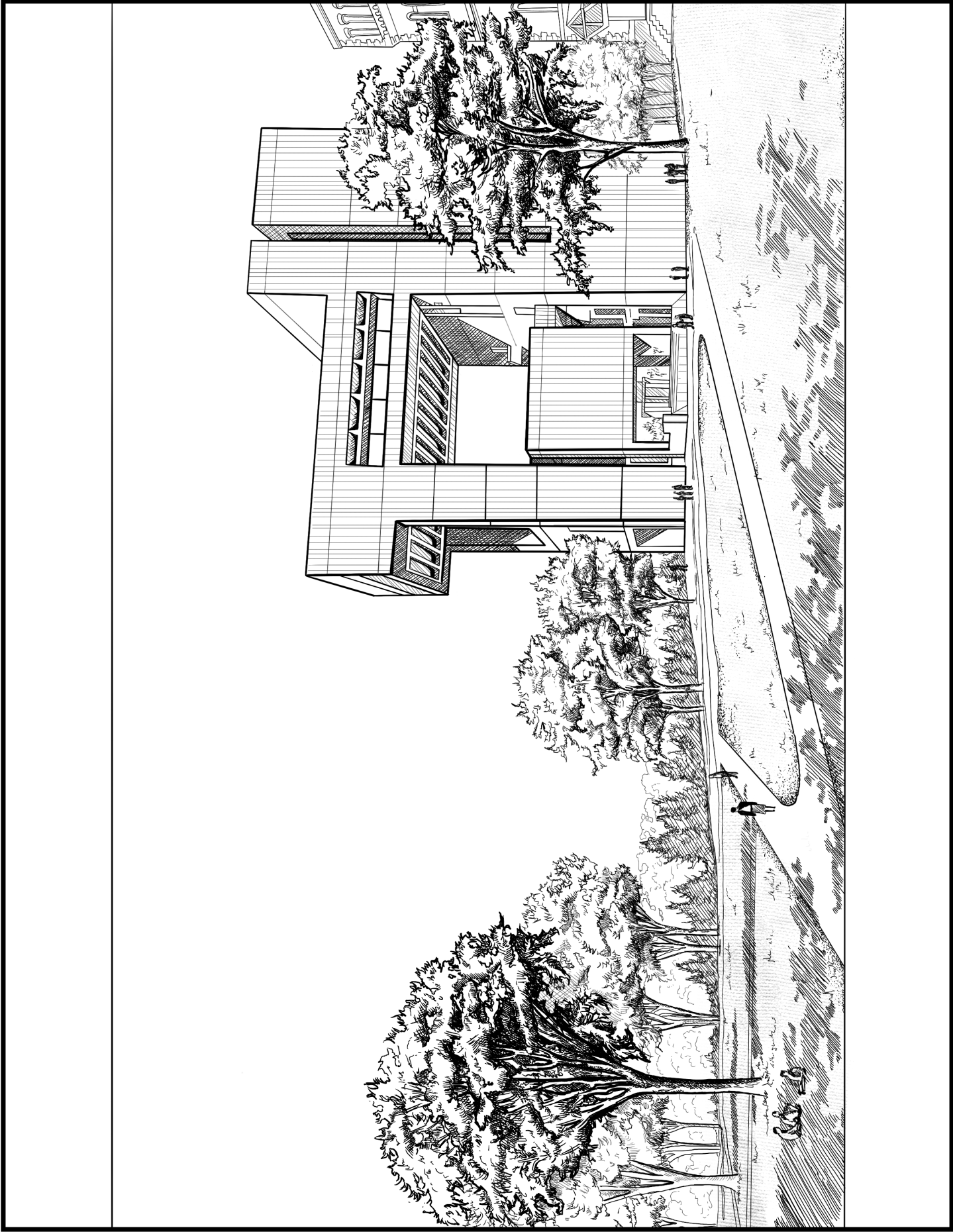
